

Thou didst not abhor the Vir - gin's womb.


When Thou hadst o - ver - come the sharp - ness of death,

thou didst open the kingdom of heaven to all be - liev - ers.


Thou sittest at the right hand of God in the glory of God the Fa - ther,

We therefore pray Thee, help Thy ser - vants,




whom Thou hast redeemed with Thy pre - cious Blood.
